Towards the implementation of the New European Research Area: status, achievements, next steps

In 2019, together with the Member States, the European Commission initiated a process to renew the European Research Area (ERA) aimed at addressing new challenges such as the twin transition.

Two years later, in 2021, the new ERA was launched with the adoption of the Pact for Research and Innovation in Europe, along with the Council conclusions on the future governance of ERA, which also ratified the first ERA Policy Agenda for 2022-2025.

The Pact for Research and Innovation defines 14 priority areas for joint action, ranging topics from open science to the coordination of research and innovation investments. It serves as a long-term framework for ERA Policy Agendas. For the period 2022-2024, these agendas encompass 20 actions based on the priority areas identified in the Pact.

What is the current status of their implementation? What milestones have been achieved so far, and what tasks remain to be completed? What's next? What lies ahead? These are some of the questions that will be addressed in the upcoming One Hour With Europe session, during which we will have the pleasure of hosting Anna Panagopoulou, Director of Directorate ERA & Innovation in DG RTD of the European Commission
