# SEWP NCP

- SEWP - completely new in FP
- Learning process even for the EC, REA and evaluators (thematic panels)
- Usually not full FTE (less calls)
- Difficult to reach all potential applicants (cutting across all thematic fields of RTDI)
- Need to built own database of contacts
- Close cooperation with all national NCPs and those from other countries needed

(originally to 31. 12. 2019, extended by an Amendment signed on 18 January 2018)

- Main aim: to create a transnational network of NCPs for SEWP under H2020 in order to facilitate transnational co-operation between NCPs with a view to identify and share good practices and raise general standards of support to applicants
- Budget EUR 1 999 521
- Coordinator: IPPT PAN (PL)

- 17 partners
- 3 partners left (2 RO, 1 LV) and 3 new joint (LV, SI, SK)
- other NCPs joint in NCP Forum (37 altogether)
- European Advisory Board: 8 internationally renowned experts
- main activities: mentoring, workshops, brokerage events, trainings, web page, newsletter, publications, collaboration with other NCP projects ...

- transfer of knowledge
- capacity building
- monitoring of stakeholders satisfaction
- workshops and trainings addressed to NCP needs expressed during the self-evaluation exercise
- networking meetings
- trans-national collaborative events as well as mentoring visits dedicated to less experienced NCPs

- WP1: Management and coordination (necessary exchange of information between partners, successful animation and coordination of the consortium, reporting)
- WP2: WIDESPREAD NCPs Capacity Building (ensuring consistent level of services across Europe through workshops, mentoring and training activities)
- WP3: Support to SEWP activities (success stories and best practices on SEWP instruments – Teaming, Twinning, ERA Chairs, COST)
- WP4: Collaboration and brokerage activities (improving, creating and coordinating collaboration opportunities)
- WP5: Dissemination of results (visibility of the network, awareness raising of SEWP - Project Portal, promotional materials, social media etc)
