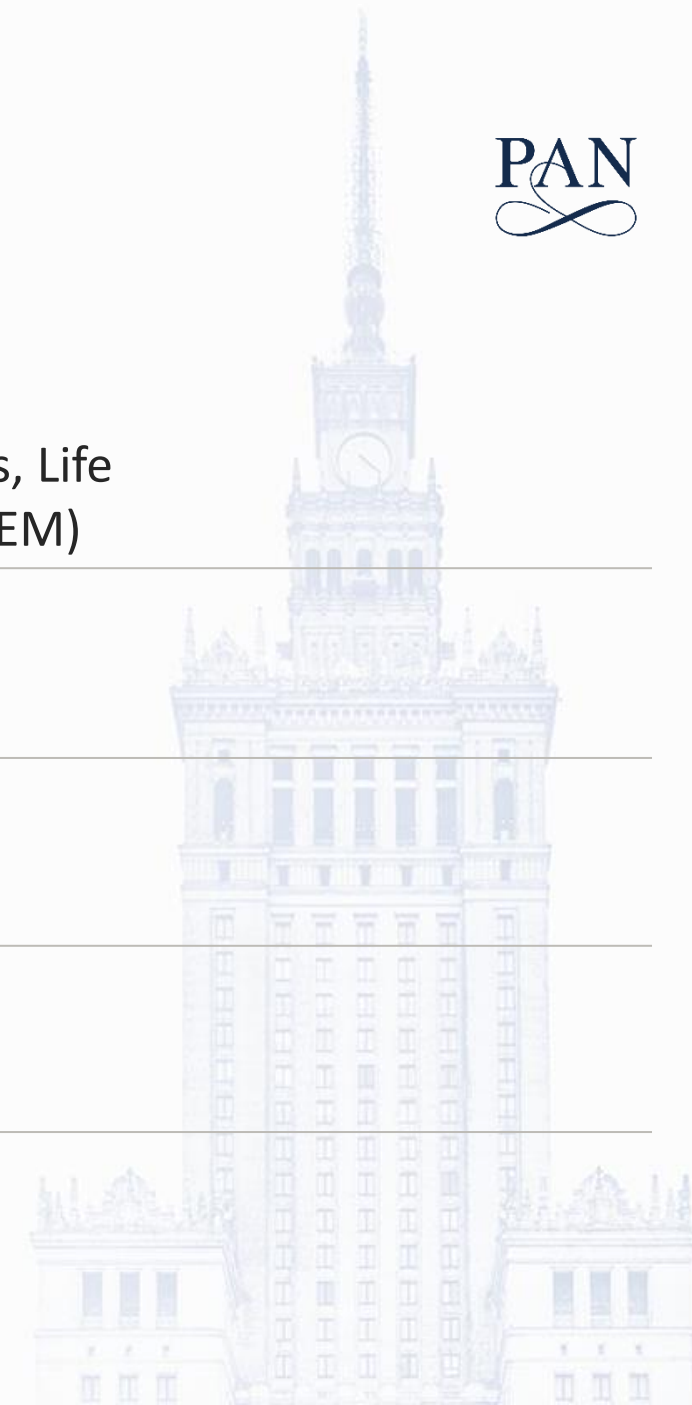

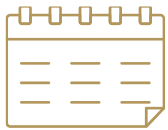

Basic facts and figures

- The war inflicted by the Russian Federation started on **24 Feb. 2022**
- Since Feb 24, **8.1 million** of Ukrainians crossed the border from UA to PL
- In 2 month time the population of Rzeszów increased by **56%**, Gdansk by 34%, Wrocław by 29%, and Warsaw by 15%
- It is estimated that ca. **6 thousand** of Ukrainian scholars left Ukraine

PAS response to the war in Ukraine



Amendment to the agreement with the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine, signed on **March 1st, 2022**. Our activities are consulted with the leadership of the NASU: Prof. Anatoly Zagorodny.



The Fellowship program for Ukrainian scholars launched on March 1st, 2022. Ukrainian **grantees at PAN keep their Ukrainian affiliation.**



We offered 3-month stipends to **60 Ukrainian scholars**. Our resources **run out in 5 days.**

International Academic Cooperation in Support of Ukraine



Our partner Academies worldwide and international organisations we are a member of provide support to scholars from UA through PAN.

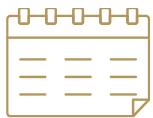


The generous support was provided by:

PAN for Ukraine in 2022



The generous support enabled us to fund **237 UA scholars in total** (including 201 women)



The additional funding allowed us to extend our stipends up to **9 months**



In December 2022 we launched a **new funding scheme addressed to researchers from UA.**

Support for Ukraine in 2023 and beyond



Under the new call we received **174 applications** from Ukrainian research teams (up to 5 members).



The projects are now under evaluation at the US NAS and we expect the results on **April 10th**



We look for institutional partners in this joint initiative who would like to **contribute financially** in this joint effort.
