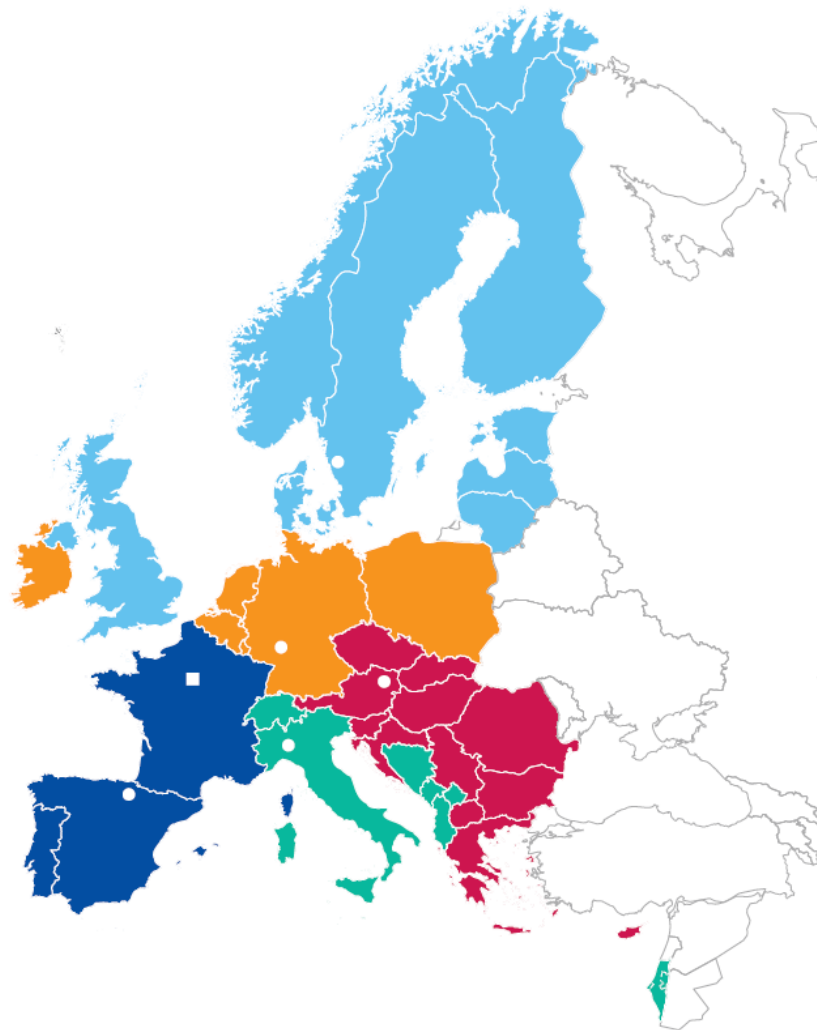

2020 Ensuring Well-skilled Future Workforce

- 12 high schools involved; engaging >2000 students and teachers; 5 RIS Countries involved: Estonia, Greece, Portugal, Slovakia, Spain
- Webinars and workshops for students on the topics of robotics and digitalization in manufacturing

2021 TBC

- Engaging >1500 participants in educational activities (including workshops about Collaborative Robot technologies)
- >20 institutions to be involved in training and mentoring activities; 7 RIS Countries involved: Estonia, Czech Republic, Greece, Lithuania, Portugal, Slovakia, Spain

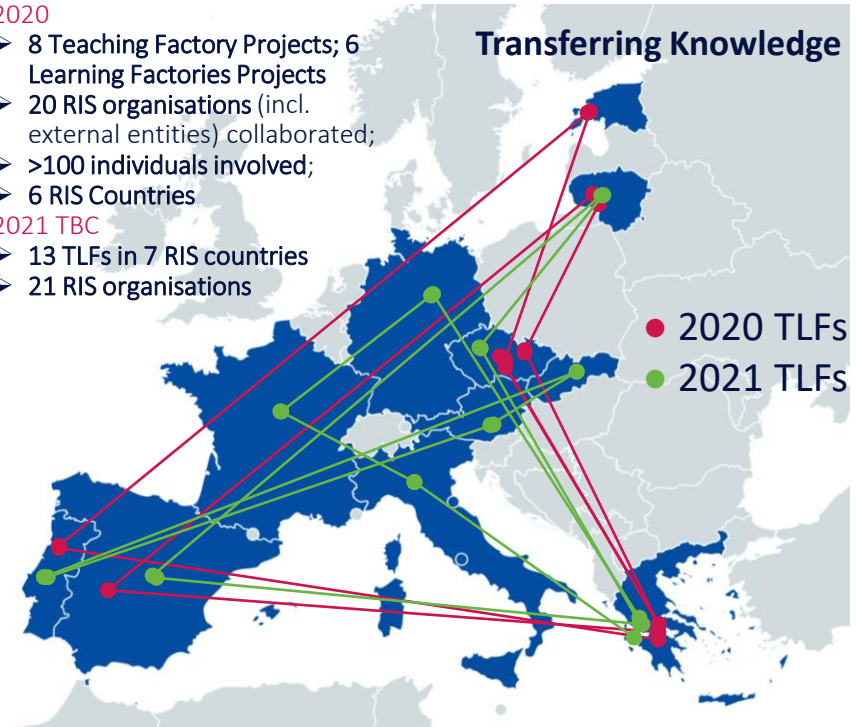
