
EIT RAWMATERIALS VISION AND MISSION

EIT RawMaterials strategic objectives are:


- 1. Securing raw materials supply: collaborating across the entire industrial value chain

- for young innovators wanting to learn the basics of entrepreneurship
- 8 months program with workshops and coaching

Start-up Accelerator

- for early phase start-ups wanting to build the company and secure market fit
- 21 months program (3 phases) with workshops, expert coaching and funding
- 2 calls per year (phase 1): https://eitrawmaterials.eu/accelerator/

Start-up and SME Booster

- for established start-ups and SMEs wanting to speed-up market introduction
- 12 months program with business support and targeted funding
- 1 open call per year (3 cut-offs): https://eitrawmaterials.eu/booster-call/

ACCELERATION – LATER PHASE

Upscaling KAVA Projects – new format since 2021

- for project consortia wanting to introduce multidisciplinary impact innovations
- open to non-partners at registration
- 2 stages process DRAFT proposals (Stage 1) and FINAL (Stage 2) proposals for selected ones at Stage 1
- strategically oriented (specific topics to address)
- 24 to 36 months projects (up to), with business support and funding
- backflow mechanism to integrate
- Min. 30% co-funding
- TRL > 5
- 2 calls per year: https://eitrawmaterials.eu/innovation/innovation-projects/


















EUROPEAN RAW MATERIALS ALLIANCE (ERMA)

- Launched on 29 September 2020 in Brussels by Commissioner Breton and VP Šefčovič (Action 1 of the EU Critical Raw Materials Action Plan)
- Coordinated by EIT RawMaterials
- > 600 partners have joined ERMA to date
- > 50 investment projects identified to date, evaluation is ongoing
