INSPIRE Centre of Excellence on Inclusive Gender Equality in Research & Innovation: Creating Knowledge & Engaging in Collaborative Action

The **European project INSPIRE** aims to develop a sustainable center for innovative, inclusive, research-based gender equality policies and tools for the academic world. It will bring together high-level researchers, gender equality experts, and practitioners to pool their ideas and resources to design new ways to implement gender equality policies.

The **subproject of INSPIRE, located at CEWS/GESIS**, aims to conduct methodological research in monitoring gender equality plans across Europe. It will be examined whether a web survey, as a reactive method of data collection, is better suited for monitoring gender equality plans or the non-reactive method of web scraping. In addition, a concept for monitoring gender equality plans (GEPs) will be developed.

What is the aim of the workshop?

- Indicating pathways to improve the monitoring of gender equality plans and the implementation of gender equality in the ERA
- Using the INSPIRE results and indicators to improve the monitoring of GEPs on different levels
 - ERA / international comparison
 - National Monitoring
- Discussing possibilities to implement the indicators and the methodologies
- Linking the INSPIRE results with other monitoring approaches and indicators
- Exploring the limits of the indicators and methods, indicating the need for future studies, and what is lacking
- Discussion of the results of the survey and the web scraping, reflecting/comparing the two methodological approaches
- Reflecting on the political consequences of the results
