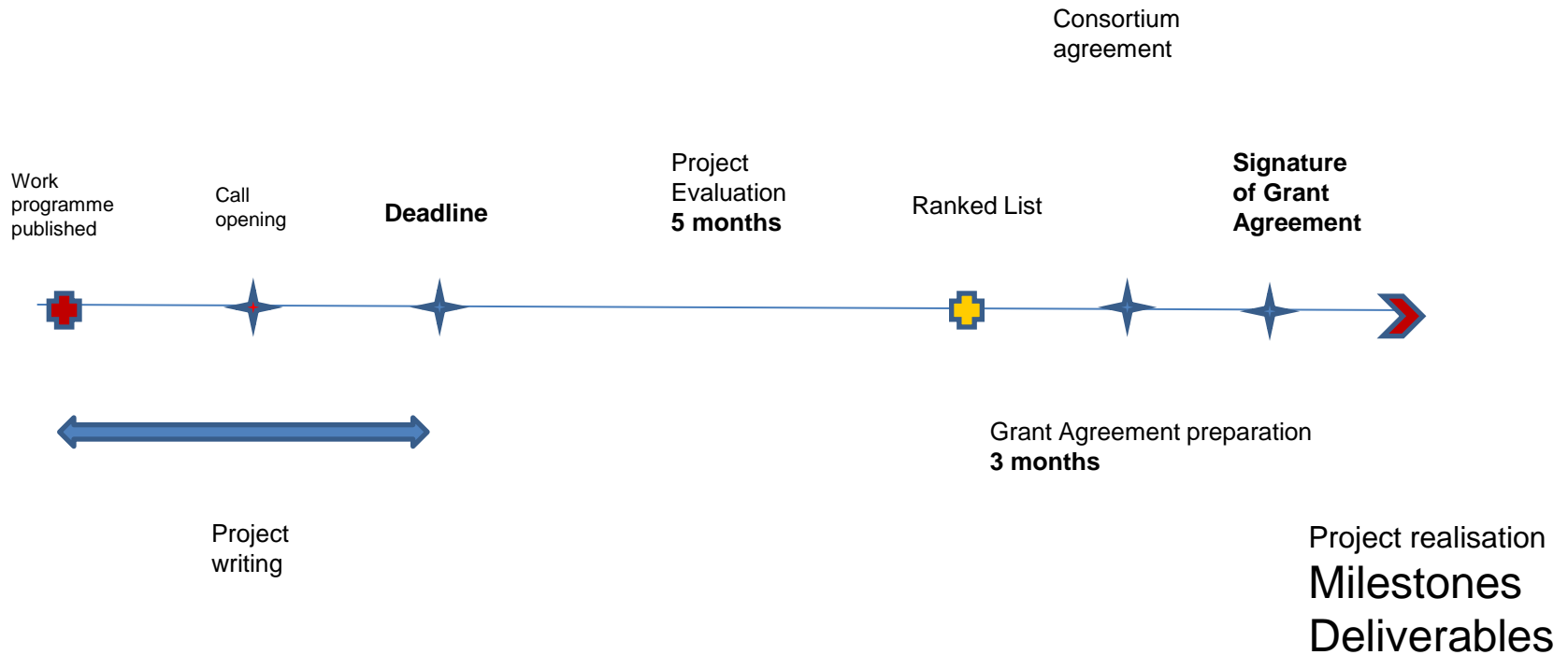

## G – Evaluation rules

**Selection criteria** (Financial capacity, operational capacity)

**Award criteria:** Excellence

Impact

Implementation

Award criteria specified according to the type of the project:

- All types of project
- RIA, IA
- CSA
- EJP Cofund actions

**Scoring and weighing:**

For full proposals, each criterion will be scored out of **5**.

The threshold for individual criteria will be **3**.

The overall threshold applying to the sum of the three individual scores, will be **10**.

For Innovation actions to determine the ranking, impact will be given the weight of 1,5.

WORK PROGRAMME 2019 – 2020

General Annexes to Euratom Work Programme 2019 - 2020

## Priority order – proposals awarded the same score within a ranked list:

- a) Topics or sub-topics *not otherwise covered* by more highly ranked proposals
- b) Criterion *excellence*; when these scores are equal, criterion *impact*
- c) If necessary, any further prioritisation will be based on the factors:
  - Number of participants from non-associated third countries
  - Gender balance among the personnel named in the proposal primarily responsible for carrying out the research and/or innovation activities
- d) Further prioritisation by panel (e.g. Synergies between projects...)
